Why N°81:

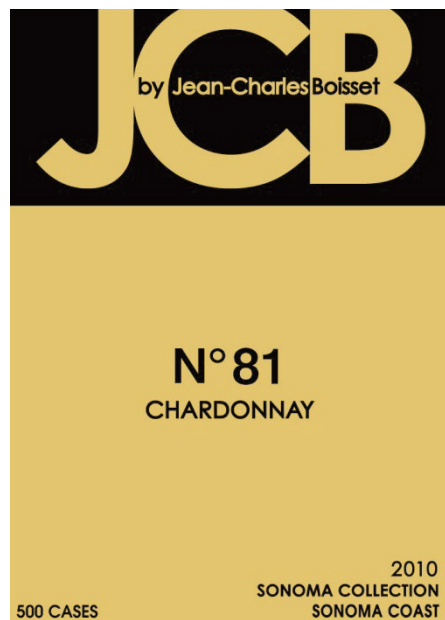
• N°81 refers to the excitement Jean-Charles felt in 1981 when he came to California from Burgundy for the first time.

Winemaking Notes:

- Aged in 50% French oak
 - 13% new oak
 - Tight-grained, medium toast
- Alc.: 13.5%
- TA: 5.0 g/L
- pH: 3.53
- 500 cases produced

Tasting Notes:

- Color: Bright straw yellow
- Aromas: Elegant aromas of ripe pear and mango
- Palate: Enticing notes of kiwi, melon and grapefruit intermingle seamlessly as this rich and creamy wine ends in a long, well-balanced finish.
