The JCB N° 69 sparkling wine is not a dainty pink wine, it is a refreshing dry rosé, with a FLAMBOYANT mouthful of lively bubbles. The VIBRANT crispness of N° 69 is thirst quenching and the flavors, evocative of pinot noir, are beautifully SENSUAL.

### BUENA VISTA 2018 MERLOT, ALEXANDER VALLEY

This wine comes from the Alexander Valley appellation, the warmest wine growing appellation in Sonoma County. Warm temperatures allow ample ripening time and rich flavor development. The 2018 Alexander Valley Merlot was aged for 11 months in 100% French oak barrels (5% new oak).

Black cherry, cassis and brambleberry flavors are accented by notes of dark chocolate, followed by a seductive and opulent finish. Available for a limited time, this limited-edition wine was hand-selected by Jean-Charles Boisset to capture the style and excellence of the Boisset Collection's portfolio of premium wineries.

### LVE 2019 CABERNET SAUVIGNON , NAPA VALLEY

The LVE Cabernet Sauvignon is a blend from three different vineyards located in St Helena, Yountville and Rutherford. The grapes from Rutherford provide backbone and structure. Fruit from St Helena brings out fresh aromatics, fruitiness and intensity. Grapes from the vineyard in Yountville contribute a savory, silky element. A dash of Petit Verdot, coming from a cool climate vineyard in Oak Knoll, brings out texture and spice.

Opening with alluring aromas of dark fruits, blackberry compote and dark chocolate, this Cabernet Sauvignon entices the senses. Sumptuous fruit-driven flavors with notes of cassis and caramelized oak are harmonious and balanced. Elegant and refined tannins with complex flavors make this an immensely enjoyable wine.

## DE LOACH 2021 "VIEILLES VIGNES" WHITE BLEND, RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY \*

The fruit for our Vieilles Vignes Blanc is harvested from the heart of the cool Russian River Valley appellation from three distinctive vineyards: Ritchie, Ricioli and Fanucchi-Wood Road. This blend is comprised of 46% Sauvignon Blanc, 45% French Colombard, 5% Trousseau Gris and 4% Viognier.

Fresh floral aromas of lemon blossom and orange marmalade leap from the glass. Luxurious and refreshing flavors entice the palate with hints of white peach, pear and fresh-cut lime. This wine displays well-integrated acidity that lingers throughout the lengthy, crisp finish. A truly delightful and invigorating white wine.

## DOMAINE PAGNIER 2019 CHARDONNAY, CHABLIS\*\*

Chablis, situated near Auxerre in the Yonne department, is home to the northernmost vineyards of France's Burgundy region. Chablis is known for its chalky subsoil dating from the Kimmeridgian period, yielding crisp Chardonnay wines with distinctive mineral characteristics.

This beautiful pale gold wine offers intense aromas of apricot and white flowers. The palate is rich and dense, with notes of citrus fruit and a touch of dried apricots. The finish is round and reveals a soft minerality.

## LOUIS BERNARD 2018 VACQUEYRAS, RED BLEND, FRANCE\*\*

This Vegan wine is a blend of Grenache, Syrah & Mourvedre. With deep purple color and expressive aromas of raspberry and candied cherries, it is chewy and dense, with ripe fruit at its core. Supple tannins are touched with spice and savory notes.

Vacqueyras' vineyards are located at the foot of the "Dentelles de Montmirail" mountain on alluvial terraces, between Vacqueyras and Sarrians. Vacqueyras was one of the first Villages to be acknowledged for the quality of its wines in 1955.

Although excellent now, this Cru will gain complexity with a cellaring period of 5 to 7 years. Perfect with roasted meat, spicy dishes, a beef stew and root vegetables.

## INTERVIEW WITH THE WINEMAKER

## STEPHANIE PUTNAM

VICE PRESIDENT OF

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We featured two extraordinary Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignons at the “Last Days of Summer Soirée” Wine Society Event at Raymond Vineyards, in September, where Stephanie shared her insights on the exquisite new vintages of the 2019 Raymond Generations, and the 2019 LVE, Legend Vineyard Exclusive.

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The Generations Cabernet is the epitome of Napa Valley. You have to make a Napa Valley cab to honor what they are: big, bold with lots of tannins. I have enjoyed working with Philippe Melka. As Consulting Winemaker, he has really helped us hone in on our style. Along with Jean Charles, we have two French men and a female, so we really want to sculpt that wine and

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tame those tannins, making it more of a balanced elegant wine. The 2019 is stunning! It has so much licorice, boysenberry and dark chocolate, almost like a cocoa character that I am loving right now. It is seamless from start to finish, it is silky and elegant. I would describe the 2019 Generations as a sexy and powerful wine.



The 2019 LVE Cabernet was one of the most fun wines I’ve made because of the partnership with John Legend. Blending wine with John Legend and Jean-Charles in the Wine Maker for a Day room was one of the best experiences I have ever had. During the initial blending, John broke out in song and sang “All of Me” acapella; that room has amazing acoustics. In wine you want balance and harmony between the fruit and the tannins without one thing overwhelming the other. It should build like a crescendo. Music is the same way, and that is why I think John Legend gravitated to wine.

With the 2019 LVE, we created a symphony, a blend of Cabernet and Petit Verdot. The Petit Verdot is really important to the style of the LVE, as it gives it a little more density and weight to the mid palate. Some of the Cabernet is from St. Helena (the same as the Generations), which will contribute licorice and blackberry components. Add in some cooler climate Yountville fruit for silky texture, and a small amount of the Rutherford Cab, which provides structure. Each appellation is a different musical instrument which comes together in a symphony, bringing it together like a balanced beautiful wine that is the 2019 LVE Napa Valley Cabernet.

## HARVEST UPDATE

**AT RAYMOND VINEYARDS, NAPA VALLEY, SEPTEMBER 9**

FEATURING THANE KNUTSON, WINE MAKER



**How is Harvest going?** Well, we are sitting in the middle of it! It has hit fast and furious in the past week. We have brought in a lot of fruit and there is still a lot out there. If you come to Raymond during the heat of harvest and spend time on the crush pad, you need to watch your back because there are forklifts, trucks and fruit everywhere. Right now there's potential, and we are optimistic and ready to see how the fruit turns out. So far it looks very good, as there's a lot of concentration in the fruit. This year we have more volume in Napa, but the yield is still on the low side, which is good for wine makers, meaning

small berries that are very concentrated. Because of lack of rain, the grapes did not size up; they do not have much juice in them.

This heat wave, with temperatures over 100°, made harvest an “all hands on deck” experience. This intensity is early, as we usually like to build up to the moment, but it hit fast. At some point, it's no different than other years: you have to bring in the fruit and juggle all the components to make it a great vintage.

We are looking to do more fun varietals with Raymond, LVE and JCB. We have the opportunity to bring in some varietals that we haven't worked with as much, such as Marsanne and Semillon. These are used as blenders in contemporary wine, but they have a place in house and are neat to work with. Even before coming in, they have unique characteristics that lend to Old World varieties, which makes it fun to make different wines.

## RASPBERRY MIMOSA

#### INGREDIENTS

- 1 lemon wedge
- 1/4 C. granulated sugar
- 1/4 C. raspberry sorbet
- 4 oz. Chambord
- 1 bottle JCB No. 69 sparkling Rosé or JCB French Kiss
- Raspberries for garnish

#### INSTRUCTIONS

Rim four champagne flutes with a lemon wedge, then dip in sugar. Place a small scoop of sorbet in each glass, then top with Chambord, JCB 69 and a few fresh raspberries.

# HOLIDAY BRISKET

RECIPE IN "CRAVINGS" BY  
CHRISSEY TEIGEN

*Pairs Phenomenally with  
the 2019 LVE Cabernet  
Sauvignon, Napa Valley*



## INGREDIENTS:

- 1 (5-pound) brisket, with a good amount of fat
- 2 TBS kosher salt, 2 tsp freshly ground black pepper, 2 TBS neutral oil
- 4 medium-large (1 1/4 pounds) carrots, cut into large chunks
- 1 1/4lbs (3 medium) onions, sliced
- 5 large cloves peeled garlic, smashed, 3 Tbs tomato paste
- 1 C beef stock, 1 C Red Wine, 2 TBS flour
- 2 (14-ounce) cans crushed tomatoes, 1/4 C dark brown sugar
- 2 TBS red wine vinegar, 5 sprigs fresh thyme, 1 bay leaf

## INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Season the brisket generously on all sides with 1 tablespoon of the salt and 1 teaspoon of the pepper.
2. Heat the oil over medium-high heat in the a Braiser or a Dutch oven until very hot but not smoking. Add the brisket, fattier side down, and sear until deep brown and crisped in parts, 6–7 minutes. Carefully flip the brisket and sear another 6 minutes, then sear each of the narrow sides, standing up the brisket if possible, 3–4 minutes each.
3. Preheat the oven to 300°F. Remove the brisket to a rimmed baking pan, then add the carrots to the oil in the pan and sear until they begin to brown, 5–6 minutes total. Add the onions and garlic and cook, stirring occasionally, until the onions soften but don't caramelize, 6–7 minutes. Add the tomato paste and cook until absorbed, 2 minutes. Add the flour and cook, stirring, 1 more minute. Add the beef stock, wine, tomatoes, brown sugar, vinegar, remaining tablespoon salt, 1 teaspoon pepper, thyme, and bay leaf. Bring to a boil, reduce the heat to low, and simmer until the sauce thickens a bit, 15 minutes.
4. Return the brisket and any accumulated juices to the braiser, then spoon some of the sauce over the top, cover, and cook until the brisket is very tender, 5 to 5 1/2 hours. Cool for 30 minutes, cover, and then chill for at least 5 hours and up to 24 if possible.
5. Remove the brisket from the sauce to a cutting board, then remove and discard any hardened fat from the sauce and scrape any off the brisket. Slice the brisket thinly across the grain, then nestle it back in the sauce in the braiser and gently warm, covered, over medium-low heat for 15 minutes, or in a 350°F oven for 25–30 minutes. Check one more time for seasoning and enjoy!


