Tasting Notes: The 2016 JCB N° 1 Cabernet Sauvignon is a blend of two vineyards, one located just west of St. Helena and the other lying in the hills of east Napa. The wine presents as a deep garnet-purple in your glass, and opens with aromas of cassis, espresso and a hint of earth. Notes of black cherry, blackberry and tapenade linger on your palate, and create a full-bodied, firm, lively and refreshing wine that is enhanced by fine-grained tannins and earthy notions. This wine melts in your mouth as it floats across your palate, leaving you wanting for more.

What The Number 1 Signifies: The N° 1 signifies Jean-Charles' vision of the penultimate wine, and the first Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon that he ever created – a wine that embraces the power of Napa Valley with the elegance of his native Burgundy. JCB N° 1 reflects the true elegance and refinement of Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon – a rare jewel in any wine collection, there can only truly ever be one N° 1.

For Jean-Charles Boisset, the N° 1 Cabernet Sauvignon must not only age well into the future, it must be **VOLUPTUOUS** in the present. It must have a commanding structure, yet have flavors that are **OPULENT**. But above all, N° 1 must always have a dramatic personality. It is never tamed and predictable. N° 1 is **INCORRIGIBLE**.
