Grape Varieties: Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot, Syrah, Merlot, Petit Syrah, Cabernet Franc and Malbec

Region: Nine Napa Valley vineyards with the majority of grapes coming from Rutherford

Winemaking Notes:

- Aged in 100% French oak
- 17% new oak
- 25 months

Tasting Notes: A Cabernet Sauvignon based blend, the 2016 Crocodile comes from 9 vineyards across the Napa Valley. Sandalwood, Blackberry and Nutmeg greet you on the nose. The Rutherford dust dances across your palate, with notes of dark cherry, chocolate and hints of cedar, rose petal and black tea. Bright acidity on the front of the palate leads to restrained power and a long lingering finish.

Like the elusive crocodile, in all its **DEVIOUS** scheming, this **FEISTY** and intricate red wine will swiftly seize your senses with all its might... causing you, its prey, to become unexpectedly **RAVENOUS** for more... until the hunted becomes the hunter.
