Napa Valley Red Wine Untameable • Sauvage • Feline



Grape Varieties: Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc

Region: Three Napa Valley floor vineyards

Winemaking Notes:

- Aged in 100% French oak
- 28% new oak
- 18-20 months

Tasting Notes: As unique as the leopard itself, this wine combines three varietals to create a balance like no other. 56% Syrah, 32% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 12% Cabernet Franc together create aromas of black currant and tobacco. Complex in the mouth, a hint of cedar compliments bold juicy flavors of reduced black cherries with an underlying herbaceousness. Empowering tannins and strong stewed fruitiness makes this a captivating wine to enjoy, and intriguing to collect.

What Leopard Signifies: The Leopard is an uncommon Napa Valley blend with enticing energy and heart. The lush, velvety femininity of the Cabernet Sauvignon unites with the animalistic spice and power of Syrah and the graceful acidity of Cabernet Franc. It is rich and dense, while delicate and feminine... It is wild and harmonious!

An inspiration from the wild, the Leopard is **UNTAMEABLE**. Comprised of the three elements... this wine brings together vine, earth and water in an exotic blend. It is mysterious and wild, the **EXOTIC** and the **SAUVAGE**, the harmonious balance of earth and freshness.
