Winemaking Notes:

Aged in 100% French oak

- 62% new barrels

Tasting Notes: This beautiful 2016 Napa Valley Cabernet strikes a deep purple-black color in the glass and opens with lovely aromas of espresso, baked plums and a hint of earthy notions. The palate offers bursting flavors of stewed cherries, crème de cassis and hints of sandalwood that lead to a rich, luscious mouthfeel. Decadent and velvety tannins are complimented by a wonderful freshness and lead to a long finish with a hint of spice.

What the Number 10 Signifies: The number 10 throughout history has always represented the concept of wholeness, soundness and being complete. This wine was uniquely designed to represent all that Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is renowned for: structure, balance and power. It is a perfect 10!

For Jean-Charles Boisset, the N° 10 Cabernet Sauvignon must not only age well into the future, it must be **DECADENT** in the present. It must have a commanding structure, yet have flavors that are **HEDONISTIC**. But above all, N° 10 must always have a dramatic personality. It is never tamed and predictable. N° 10 is **NOBLE**.
