Grape Variety: 100% Chardonnay

Tasting Notes: The blend of three appellations (Saint-Aubin, Saint-Romain et Saint-Véran) each expresses its terroir, yet their personalities mingle together to create a harmonious whole that is all freshness and elegance. Pale golden in colour with fine bubbles, the nose is buttery and opens with fresh fruit notes of citrus, white flowers and acacia honey. The palate is balanced and complex.
