### Tasting Notes:

The Pinot Noir grapes for the JCB N° 6 come from vineyards in the northwestern Russian River Valley which gives the wine structure and a backbone, and from the Olivet Bench area in the middle of the Russian River Valley which provide the core of this wine with notes of red fruit and earth. On the palate you are greeted with smoked cherry, cinnamon and black cardamom, and cranberry. The wine is full-bodied in nature, dense on your palate, yet remains light and finishes with a bright acidity that leaves you wanting more.

What The Number 6 Signifies: In honor of the very first JCB wine, a California Pinot Noir from the 2006 vintage, N° 6 pays tribute to the inception of a grand collection of boutique wines destined to set a new standard epitomizing luxury and style.
