GRAPE VARIETY: Cabernet Sauvignon

REGION: Napa Valley, California

WINEMAKING NOTES: Aged 18-19 months in small French oak barrels. Harvested and bottled entirely on fruit days

- 30% new French oak (Ermitage, Baron, Taransaud)
- Fermentation (all extended maceration) on skins for an average of 39 days
- Alcohol: 15%
- pH: 3.69
- T/A: 6.4 g/L
- Vegan, bottled unfiltered and unfiltered

TASTING NOTES: Our 2021 JCB N° 1 is a blend of three vineyards, 70% St. Helena fruit and the remaining 30% from the eastern hills above Stags Leap. Rich and authoritative, this wine demonstrates a deep purple hue in the glass, unveiling aromas of blackberry and plum that linger on your palate.

WHAT THE NUMBER 1 SIGNIFIES: The N° 1 signifies Jean-Charles' vision of the penultimate wine, and the first Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon that he ever created – a wine that embraces the power of Napa Valley with the elegance of his native Burgundy. JCB N° 1 reflects the true elegance and refinement of Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon – a rare jewel in any wine collection, there can only truly ever be one N° 1.

For Jean-Charles Boisset, the N° 1 Cabernet Sauvignon must not only age well into the future, it must be VOLUPTUOUS in the present. It must have a commanding structure, yet have flavors that are OPULENT. But above all, N° 1 must always have a dramatic personality. It is never tamed and predictable. N° 1 is INCORRIGIBLE.
