GRAPE VARIETY: Pinot Noir

REGION: Sonoma Coast, California

WINEMAKING NOTES: Aged in French oak for 18

months - 30% new oak. Malolactic fermentation.

Alcohol: 13.5% | pH: 3.55 | T/A: 5.4 g/L

TASTING NOTES: The nose first unveils an alluring medley of an inviting array of cherries, dried cranberries, and a whisper of mossy forest floor. On the palate, this delicately profound Pinot Noir unfurls a tapestry of flavors, including dark stewed fruit, the freshness of oak, and subtle notes of strawberry all elegantly counterbalanced by its vivacious acidity. JCB N° 11, is a bold yet ethereal offering culminating in an enduring, refined finish that lingers gracefully.

WHAT THE NUMBER I I SIGNIFIES: For Jean-Charles, the age of ll was a magical time in life, an age of endless possibilities and burgeoning dreams. Inevitably, the number ll became the number behind the wine, one of his favorite Pinot Noirs, and a reminder of an enchanting time in life.

N° 11 is always SPONTANEOUS. Harmonious and balanced, it is quite GRACEFUL. With a texture like a velvet jacket, luscious flavors, and a seductively long finish, N° 11 is ROMANTIC, reminiscent of an evening by a glowing fire.
