GRAPE VARIETY: Cabernet Sauvignon & Petite Verdot

REGION: Napa Valley, California

WINEMAKING NOTES: Aged 18-19 months in small French oak barrels - 36% new French (Ermitage, Baron). Fermentation (all extended maceration) and on skins for between 40 -46 days. The Cabernet Sauvignon was harvested on a fruit day; the Petite Verdot was harvested on a flower day, and was then bottled on a fruit day. Vegan, bottled unfinned and unfiltered.
Alcohol: 15% | pH: 3.65 | T/A: 6.3g/L

TASTING NOTES: This 2021 vintage hails from two vineyards in St. Helena (Cabernet Sauvignon) and Rutherford (Petite Verdot). Boasting dark berries, cedar, and toasted nuances of spice, this wine will undoubtedly stimulate your desire for another sip. The lavish mouthfeel envelops your palate; the tannins, profoundly rich and compact, all contribute to the its elegance and aging potential.

WHAT THE SURREALIST SIGNIFIES: The Surrealist by JCB is a wine that has never been done before as a blend from the Napa Valley – seductive, lush and opulent, rich yet silky with an eternal finish... A union of power, femininity, elegance and grace. This transcendent wine is a surrealistic expression of our dreams for the ultimate Napa Valley red wine.
